
The Importance of Prophecy




- The Reality of God
- Esp. in contrast to false gods and idols




- Isaiah 41:21-24
- Bring your proofs ... Or declare to us the things to come.



- Tell us what is to come hereafter, that we may know that you are gods
- Behold you are nothing, and your work is less than nothing.




- Isaiah 46:8-11
- I am God, and there is none like me, declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done, saying, "My counsel shall stand and I will accomplish all my purpose ...




I have spoken, and I will bring it to pass; I have purposed, and I will do it




- The Power of God
- Demonstrates God's ability to state His purposes and the accomplish them through His power.



• Isaiah 55:11: So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.




Numbers 23:19: God is not man, that he should lie, or a son of man, that he should change his mind. Has he said, and will he not do it? Or has he spoken, and will he not fulfill it?




- Isaiah 9:7: Of the increase of his government and of peace
- there will be no end,
- on the throne of David and over his kingdom,
- to establish it and to uphold it
- with justice and with righteousness
- from this time forth and forevermore.
- The zeal of the Lord of hosts will do this.




- Purpose of God
- Reminds us that the things that have happened were not accidental or coincidental.
- Result of God's plan for our salvation; His purpose from eternity.




• Ephesians 3:11: This was according to the eternal purpose that he has realized in Christ Jesus our Lord,




- Isaiah 46:11: calling a bird of prey from the east,
- the man of my counsel from a far country.
- I have spoken, and I will bring it to pass;
- I have purposed, and I will do it.




2 Timothy 1:9: who saved us and called us to a holy calling, not because of our works but because of his own purpose and grace, which he gave us in Christ Jesus before the ages began,




- Most clearly seen in Jesus Christ
- Messianic prophecies reveal the truth not only about God and His plan
- But verifies the salvation through His Son the Messiah




Messianic prophecies




- Over 300 prophecies in OT about Messiah ... fulfilled in Jesus Christ
- All prophecies over 400 yrs before Jesus born (dead sea scrolls)
- Most much older
- Isaiah about 700 years before Jesus.




- Micah 5:2: born in bethlehem
- Matthew 2:1
- Out of Jesus' control
- Not the home town of Jesus' parents: Joseph and Mary, Nazareth in Galilee




- God would have to make sure that Mary is in Bethlehem for Jesus to be born.
 - How accomplished? Luke 2:1-7
 - A decree from Caeser Augustus for all the world to be registered, so both Joseph and Mary were required to travel to Bethlehem (House of David)




2 Peter 1:19-21: And we have the prophetic word more fully confirmed, to which you will do well to pay attention as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts, 20 knowing this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture comes from someone's own interpretation. 21 For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit



- Isaiah 53:7-8: He was oppressed, and he was afflicted,
- yet he opened not his mouth;
- · like a lamb that is led to the slaughter,
- and like a sheep that before its shearers is silent,
- so he opened not his mouth.
- 8 By oppression and judgment he was taken away;
- and as for his generation, who considered
- that he was cut off out of the land of the living,
- stricken for the transgression of my people



- telling us what will happen
 - 1, 3) Rejected
 - 5) wounded and crushed
 - 7) opened not his mouth
 - 8) killed
 - 9) buried with rich



- also WHY it happened
 - 5-6
 - 12
