
- The Importance of Prophecy: Reality, Power, Purpose

- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ Show that Jesus is the Christ, Messiah that God always planned to send for our salvation.






- Acts 8:30-35

- 31 And he said, "How can I, unless someone guides me?"







- For the language of the Bible is employed to express, under the inspiration of the Holy Ghost, many thing which are beyond the power and scope of the reason of man.








- Why does their doctrine change?

 - "Heresy" of Americanism.




Religious liberty




- Separation of Church and State
 - 55. The Church ought to be separated from the .State, and the State from the Church. -- Allocution "Acerbissimum," Sept. 27, 1852.




- Second Vatican Council (1962-1965)
 - all people have a human right to religious freedom
 - "This Vatican Council declares that the human person has a right to religious freedom." Dignitatis Humanae




- the Church is separate from the State
 - This freedom means that all men are to be immune from coercion on the part of individuals or of social groups and of any human power, in such wise that no one is to be forced to act in a manner contrary to his own beliefs, whether privately or publicly, whether alone or in association with others, within due limits.



"morphed from heresy to official Church teaching"




- There was a time, when it was not fully understood what God was planning.
- Angels longed to look…
- 1 Peter 1:10-12: Concerning this salvation, the prophets who prophesied about the grace that was to be yours searched and inquired carefully, 11 inquiring what person or time the Spirit of Christ in them was indicating when he predicted the sufferings of Christ and the subsequent glories. 12 It was revealed to them that they were serving not themselves but you, in the things that have now been announced to you through those who preached the good news to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven, things into which angels long to look.

- Romans 16:25: Now to him who is able to strengthen you according to my gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery that
 was kept secret for long ages
- Note: mystery REVEALED!




- OT scriptures helpful, useful... even if not complete revelation
- 2 Timothy 3:15: and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.




Now revealed to saints




• Paul made known by revelation... written... Read... perceive




- You can understand the Scriptures


- Jesus and Baptism

- Why Did the Ethiopian want to be baptized?




- Acts 8:35-36: Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning with this Scripture he told him the good news about Jesus. And as they were going along the road they came to some water, and the eunuch said, "See, here is water! What prevents me from being baptized.
- Cannot separate the concepts of Jesus, salvation and baptism by immersion for forgiveness of sins.




- Baptism Saves
- 1 Peter 3:21: Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ,



- Death, Burial, Resurrection
- 1 Corinthians 15:1-4: 1 Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you stand, 2 and by which you are being saved, if you hold fast to the word I preached to you— unless you believed in vain. 3 For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received:that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, 4 that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures



- Death, Burial, Resurrection
- Romans 6:3-4: Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? 4 We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life



- Water and complete immersion
- Acts 8:36-39: And as they were going along the road they came to some water, and the eunuch said, "See, here is water! What prevents me from being baptized?" 38 And he commanded the chariot to stop, and they both went down into the water, Philip and the eunuch, and he baptized him. 39 And when they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord carried Philip away, and the eunuch saw him no more, and went on his way rejoicing.
