




Our God Knows How to Judge




To grow to maturity we must understand the eternal judgment.





- 8 But do not overlook this one fact, beloved, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. 9 The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.
- God is patient.
 - God's patience is an expression of his love for all of us.
 - We've all sinned: ungodly
 - Judgment should be AGAINST us.
 - But God doesn't want anyone to perish.
 - If we perish, it's our own choice.
 - He waits patiently for us to return to him.

- not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.
- But to not perish, change must happen.
 - Turn away from unbelief, rebellion, immorality, ungodliness
 - Turn away from corruption, wickedness, violence
 - Turn to God
 - Father
 - Savior
 - Reconciliation
- ⁻ This changes everything about the day of judgment.
 - No longer fear that day
 - Look forward to that day... be with Him.


