
Romans 1:24 (ESV) Therefore God gave them up in the lusts of their hearts to impurity, to the dishonoring of their bodies among themselves,



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




- Romans 2:6 (ESV): He will render to each one according to his **works**:




- Romans 2:5 (ESV): But because of your hard and impenitent heart you are storing up wrath for yourself on the day of wrath when God's righteous judgment will be revealed.


- Romans 2:8 (ESV) 8 but for those who are self-seeking and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness






- Romans 2:9: for every human being who does evil, the Jew first and also the Greek,




- Romans 2:10 (ESV) for everyone who does good, the Jew first and also the Greek.




- Romans 2:8-9 (ESV) there will be wrath and fury. 9 There will be tribulation and distress




- 7: seek for glory and honor and immortality, he will give eternal life
- Romans 2:10: but glory and honor and peace for everyone who does good, the Jew first and also the Greek.




Romans 3:9 (ESV): What then? Are we Jews any better off? No, not at all. For we have already charged that all, both Jews and Greeks, are under sin,
 Romans 3:22: For there is no distinction: 23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,



- <sup>-</sup> 22 the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe.
- 24: through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, 25 whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith.
- <sup>-</sup> 26: so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

- Romans 3:21-26 (ESV) 21 But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law,
  - although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it-
- 22 the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe.
- This was to show God's righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over former sins.
- 26 It was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.
