


- Consequences of not pressing on



 Hebrews 6:1 (ESV) Therefore let us leave the elementary doctrine of Christ and go on to maturity, not laying again a foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God,




- Philippians 3:12 (ESV) 12 Not that I have already obtained this or am already perfect, but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own.



- Toward the Goal
 - v. 14: prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus
 - v. 8: knowing Christ
 - v. 9: found in him
 - v. 9: righteousness from God through faith
 - v. 10: know Him and power of resurrection
 - v. 10: share in sufferings
 - v. 10: like him in his death
 - v. 11: resurrection from the dead






Colossians 1:28: Him we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all wisdom, that we may present everyone mature in Christ.

1 Corinthians 2 (ESV) 1 And I, when I came to you, brothers, did not come proclaiming to you the testimony of God with lofty speech or wisdom. 2 For I decided to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ and him crucified. 3 And I was with you in weakness and in fear and much trembling, 4 and my speech and my message were not in plausible words of wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, 5 so that your faith might not rest in the wisdom of men but in the power of God. 6 Yet among the mature we do impart wisdom, although it is not a wisdom of this age or of the rulers of this age, who are doomed to pass away. 7 But we impart a secret and hidden wisdom of God, which God decreed before the ages for our glory. 8 None of the rulers of this age understood this, for if they had, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory. 9 But, as it is written, "What no eye has seen, nor ear heard, nor the heart of man imagined, what God has prepared for those who love him" — 10 these things God has revealed to us through the Spirit. For the Spirit searches everything, even the depths of God. 11 For who knows a person's thoughts except the spirit of that person, which is in him? 
- . Teaching

- _ Unskilled
 - (CWSB Dictionary) Inexperienced, unskillful (Heb. 5:13), ignorant of true doctrine



- Know basic doctrines ("Good enough!")
- Struggle with more difficult issues and understandings
- Struggle with applying to our lives.



- Solid Food
- (Vine's Complete Expository Dictionary) As "solid" food requires more powerful digestive organs than are possessed by a babe, so a fuller knowledge of Christ (especially here with reference to His Melchizedek priesthood) required that exercise of spiritual intelligence which is derived from the practical appropriation of what had already been received.




- Psalms 34:11 (ESV) Come, O children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the Lord.
- Psalms 34:14 (ESV) 14 Turn away from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it.






- powers of discernment (senses)
- (Vine's Complete Expository Dictionary) "senses," the capacities for spiritual apprehension. In the Sept., Jer. 4:19, "(I am pained... in the) sensitive powers (of my heart)."





 - _ (different "discern"; this one about "judgment")




- Proverbs 1:7 (ESV) 7 The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction.




- Proverbs 14:8 (ESV Strong's) 8 The wisdom of the prudent is to discern his way, but the folly of fools is deceiving.
- Jesus: two paths: broad or narrow



- Proverbs 14:15 (ESV Strong's) 15 The simple believes everything, but the prudent gives thought to his steps.



- Proverbs 17:10 (ESV) 10 A rebuke goes deeper into a man of understanding than a hundred blows into a fool.








- False Prophets




- 1 Timothy 4:7 (ESV) 7 Have nothing to do with irreverent, silly myths. Rather train yourself for godliness
 - We are easily distracted by myths (ideas about God, Bible, Religion that are distractions)
 - Godliness (living righteously with Godly fear)



1 Corinthians 9:24-27 (ESV) 24 Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one receives the prize? So run that you may obtain it. 25 Every athlete exercises self-control in all things. They do it to receive a perishable wreath, but we an imperishable. 26 So I do not run aimlessly; I do not box as one beating the air.
27 But I discipline my body and keep it under control, lest after preaching to others I myself should be disqualified.



- Philippians 2:12-13 (ESV) 12 Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, 13 for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.
