





- · Talking about zeal... Jehovah's zeal; Jesus' zeal; next lesson seemed obvious: Holy Spirit's zeal




· Numbers 13:1-2 (ESV) 1 The Lord spoke to Moses, saying, 2 "Send men to spy out the land of Canaan, which I am giving to the people of Israel. From each tribe of their fathers you shall send a man, every one a chief among them."




- · Numbers 13:27 (ESV) And they told him, "We came to the land to which you sent us. It flows with milk and honey, and this is its fruit.
- Numbers 13:28-29 (ESV) 28 However, the people who dwell in the land are strong, and the cities are fortified and very large. And besides, we saw the descendants of Anak there. 29 The Amalekites dwell in the land of the Negeb. The Hittites, the Jebusites, and the Amorites dwell in the hill country. And the Canaanites dwell by the sea, and along the Jordan."




- · Numbers 13:30 (ESV) 30 But Caleb quieted the people before Moses and said, "Let us go up at once and occupy it, for we are well able to overcome it."
- Numbers 13:31-33 (ESV) 31 Then the men who had gone up with him said, "We are not able to go up against the people, for they are stronger than we are." 32 So they brought to the people of Israel a bad report of the land that they had spied out, saying, "The land, through which we have gone to spy it out, is a land that devours its inhabitants, and all the people that we saw in it are of great height. 33 And there we saw the Nephilim (the sons of Anak, who come from the Nephilim), and we seemed to ourselves like grasshoppers, and so we seemed to them."









4 And they said to one another, "Let us choose a leader and go back to Egypt."




• And the Lord's anger was kindled against Israel, and he made them wander in the wilderness forty years, until all the generation that had done evil in the sight of the Lord was gone.




· Before they enter land, 40 years later, Moses summarizes this incident: Deut. 1






- · After wandering in wilderness 40 years

- · First conquer the nations of Moab and Midian
- · Good land for livestock, decide to stay.






• 6 But Moses said to the people of Gad and to the people of Reuben, "Shall your brothers go to the war while you sit here?




• 7 Why will you discourage the heart of the people of Israel from going over into the land that the Lord has given them?




• 8 Your fathers did this, when I sent them from Kadesh-barnea to see the land. 9 For when they went up to the Valley of Eshcol and saw the land, they discouraged the heart of the people of Israel from going into the land that the Lord had given them.



• 10 And the Lord's anger was kindled on that day, and he swore, saying, 11 'Surely none of the men who came up out of Egypt, from twenty years old and upward, shall see the land that I swore to give to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, because they have not wholly followed me,



• 12 none except Caleb the son of Jephunneh the Kenizzite and Joshua the son of Nun, for they have wholly followed the Lord.' 13 And the Lord's anger was kindled against Israel, and he made them wander in the wilderness forty years, until all the generation that had done evil in the sight of the Lord was gone.



• 14 And behold, you have risen in your fathers' place, a brood of sinful men, to increase still more the fierce anger of the Lord against Israel! 15 For if you turn away from following him, he will again abandon them in the wilderness, and **you will destroy all this people."**

# WHAT HAPPENS WHEN I QUENCH THE SPIRIT IN MY BRETHREN?

- · What happens when I quench the Spirit in my brethren?
- · Two examples demonstrate that my actions affect my brethren.
  - $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$  What I do, or don't do, can affect this congregation either positively or negatively.



### Discourage

- · Numbers 32:7: Why will you discourage the heart of the people of Israel?
- $\cdot\,$  Numbers 32:9: They discouraged the heart of the people of Israel from going into the land
- · Deuteronomy 1:28: Our brothers have made our hearts melt



#### Evil

- · Numbers 32:13: all the generation that had done evil in the sight of Jehovah
- $\cdot\,$  Deuteronomy 1:26: Yet you would not go up, but rebelled against the command of Jehovah your God.



- Destroy the people
  - · Numbers 32:15: you will destroy all this people
    - Note: "you" = those who caused discouragement (not God)



- · Not excusing individual responsibility for our actions: if I rebel, complain, then it's on me.
- · But my actions can make it easier for others to fail to trust God and rebel.



- Am I advancing the plan and purpose of God, in his way?
  - · Or am I standing/sitting in the way?
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$  Am I saying things that hurt, discourage, hinder, question God?
