Matthew 11:16


- Children calling to playmates

  Son of Man came eating and drinking, and they say, 'Look at him! A glutton and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and sinners!' Yet wisdom is justified by her
  deeds."

• 12 For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the basic principles of the oracles of God.




• You need milk, not solid food, 13 for everyone who lives on milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, since he is a child.

## Become Like Children

unless you turn and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven Matthew 18:3

• Matthew 18:1-6 (ESV) 1 At that time the disciples came to Jesus, saying, "Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?" 2 And calling to him a child, he put him in the midst of them 3 and said, "Truly, I say to you, unless you turn and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. 4 Whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven. 5 "Whoever receives one such child in my name receives me, 6 but whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better for him to have a great millstone fastened around his neck and to be drowned in the depth of the sea.

## Become Like Children

Let the little children come to me and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 19:14

• Matthew 19:13-15 (ESV) 13 Then children were brought to him that he might lay his hands on them and pray. The disciples rebuked the people, 14 but Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven." 15 And he laid his hands on them and went away.

- Mature Children
  - There's a paradox ... this should push us to deeper thoughts
  - The common interpretation (humble) may not be sufficient.
    - I think there's more here

unless you turn and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven Matthew 18:3

- Jesus doesn't emphasize just having the nature of a child
- TURN
  - There's something that's happened to us as we've grown up.
  - And it's something that we need to change
  - But what happens to children as they are growing?
    - What is that we have learned?
    - What needs to be unlearned?
    - What must we learn again?

- Church in Corinth

- Many in Greece were very proud of their culture of wisdom
  - Aristotle, Plato, Socrates, etc.
  - They loved hearing new things (Athens)

1 Corinthians 2:6

- We are not far different
  - We still honor these men of the past, but also modern (Einstein, Musk, et. al.)
  - We make a big deal about degrees and publications
- There is still a wisdom of the world, a wisdom that comes from the mind of man
  - (It's not always wrong)
- Proverbs 4:7 The beginning of wisdom is this: Get wisdom, and whatever you get, get insight.
- Proverbs 2:6 For the LORD gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding;

• 1 Corinthians 3:1-4 (ESV) 1 But I, brothers, could not address you as spiritual people, but as people of the flesh, as infants in Christ. 2 I fed you with milk, not solid food, for you were not ready for it. And even now you are not yet ready, 3 for you are still of the flesh. For while there is jealousy and strife among you, are you not of the flesh and behaving only in a human way? 4 For when one says, "I follow Paul," and another, "I follow Apollos," are you not being merely human?

1 Corinthians 3:1

- Spiritual vs. flesh
  - flesh is infants in Christ (This is the growth encouraged in other passages)
    - The implication is that they hadn't changed... still thinking like the world.
    - Evidence is poor behavior that is selfish.

Brothers, do not be children in your thinking.

Be infants in evil, but in your thinking be mature.

1 Corinthians 14:20

- 1 Corinthians 14:20 (ESV) 20 Brothers, do not be children in your thinking. Be infants in evil, but in your thinking be mature.
- This sounds like the opposite of what I'm arguing, I know.
- $\bullet\,$  Again it's about two ways of thinking ...
  - Are we thinking like the world and the flesh?
  - Are we going to think like God and be spiritually minded?

Know then that it is those of faith who are the sons of Abraham.

Galatians 3:7

- Galatians 3:7-9 (ESV) 7 Know then that it is those of faith who are the sons of Abraham. 8 And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "In you shall all the nations be blessed." 9 So then, those who are of faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.
- Faith ... sons of Abraham ... blessed

Brothers, do not be children in your thinking.

Be infants in evil, but in your thinking be mature.

1 Corinthians 14:20

- God wants you to be mature, to grow up spiritually
  - Ephesians 5:1-2 (ESV) 1 Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children. 2 And walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.
- A large part of this is turning how we think.
  - We've learned the ways of the world, the flesh.
  - Now we need to think like our Father thinks.
  - James 3:13ff
  - Spiritually mature thinking and living and behavior
    - LOVE!
