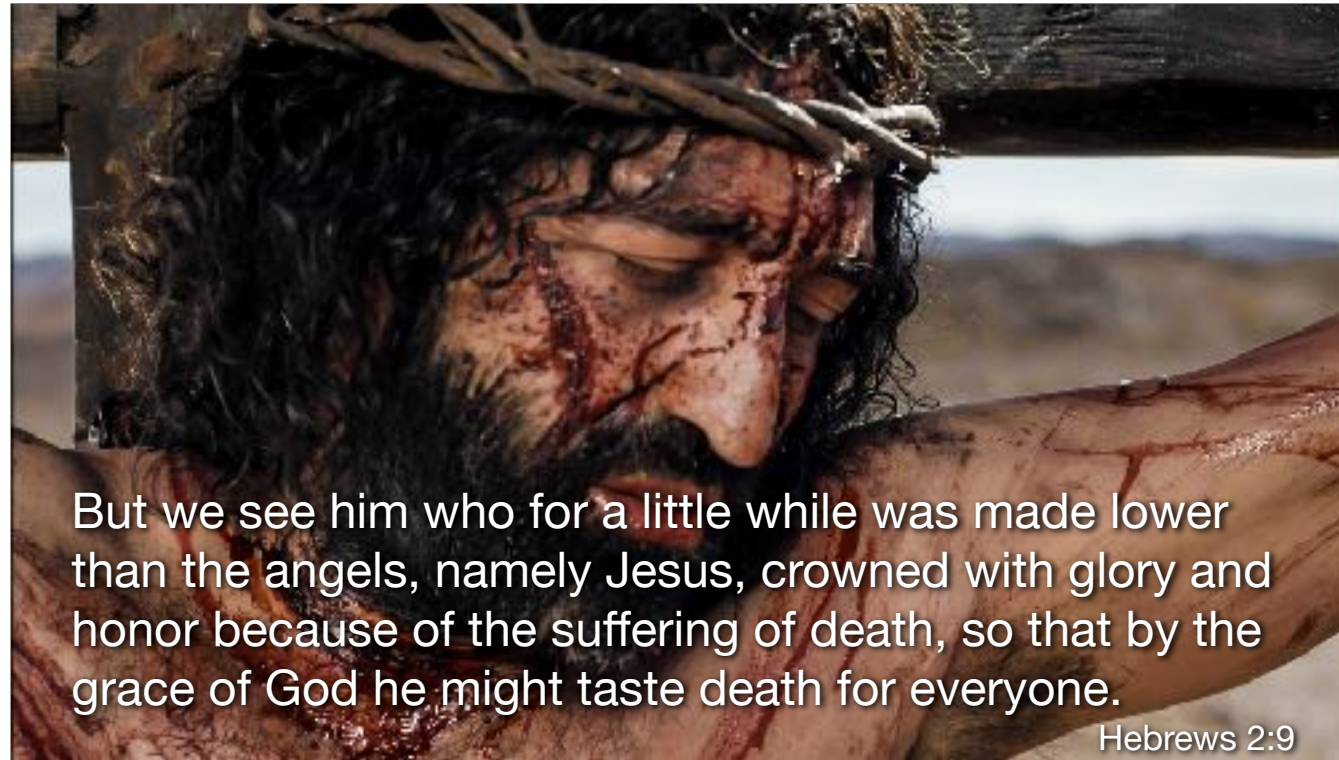

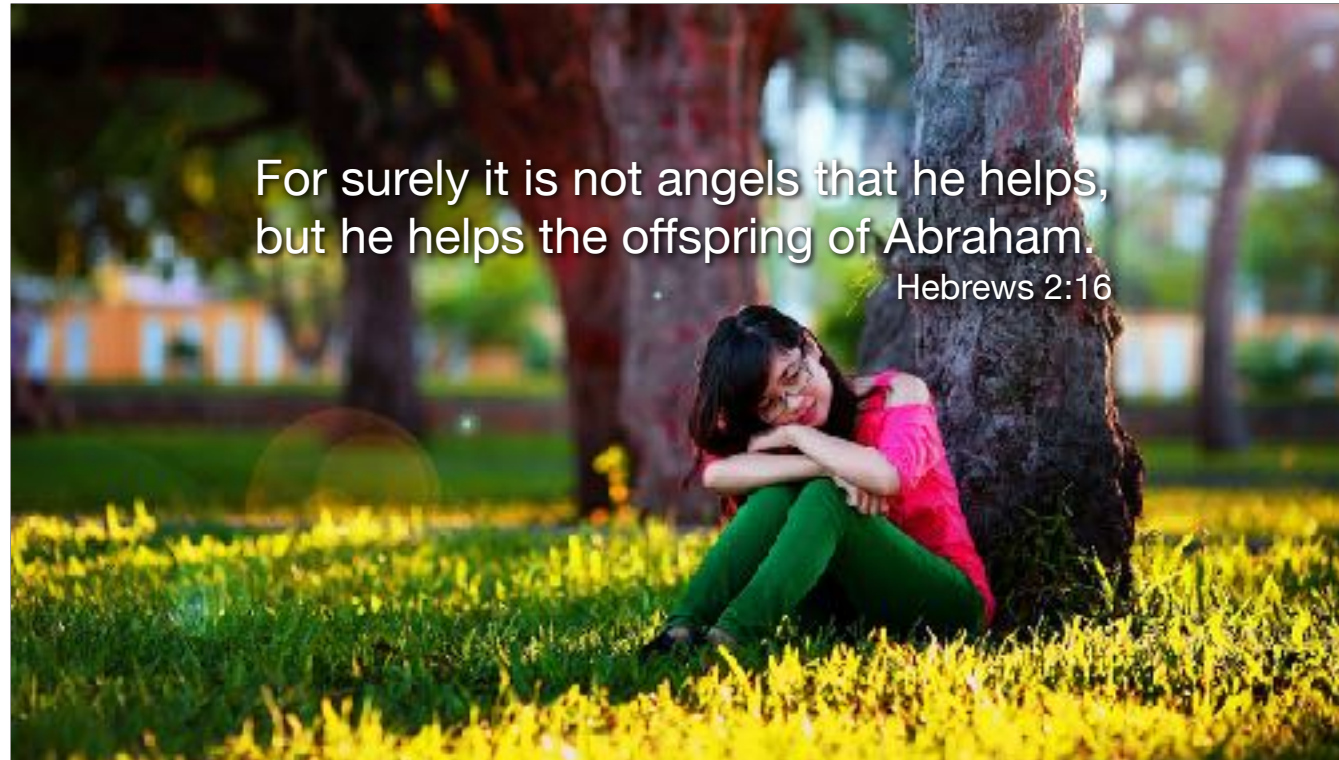

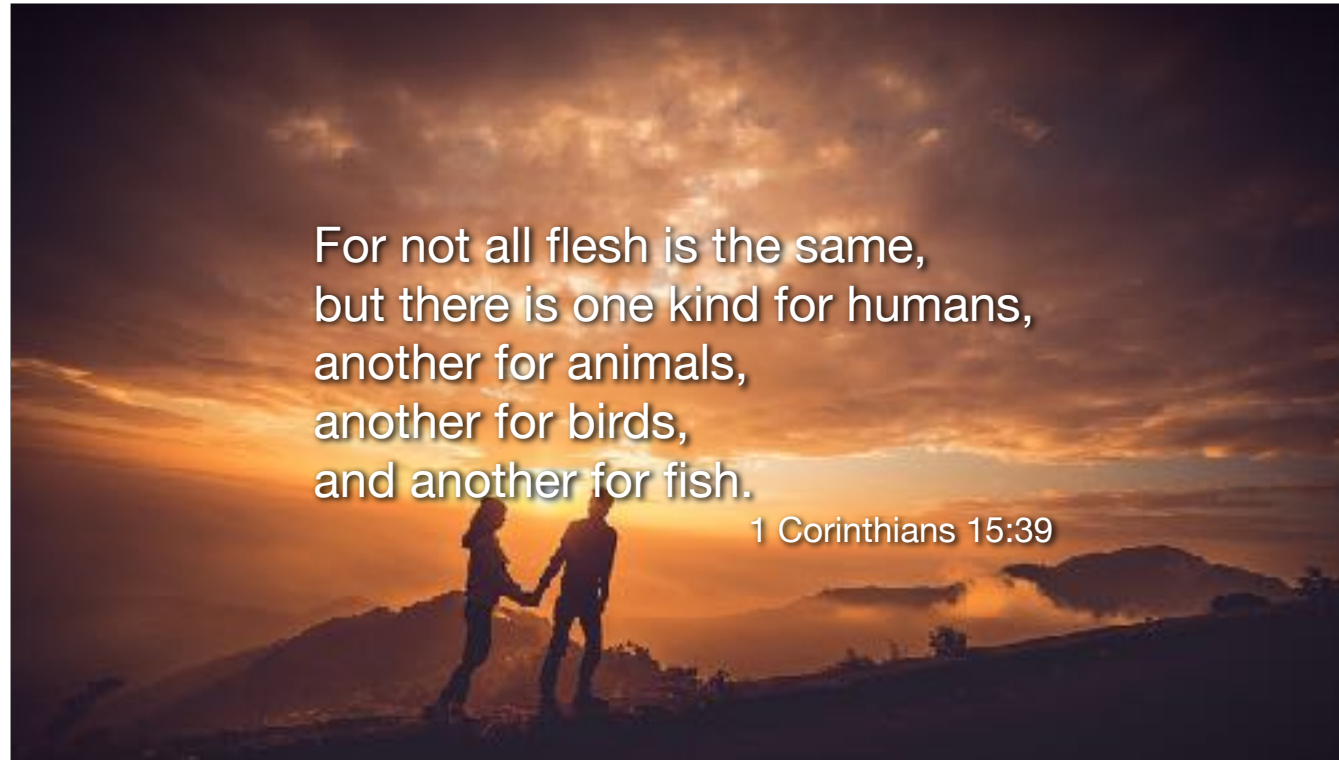

- Hebrews 2:18 (ESV) 18 For because he himself has suffered when tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted.




- Genesis 1:26 Then God said, “Let us make man in our image, after our likeness.

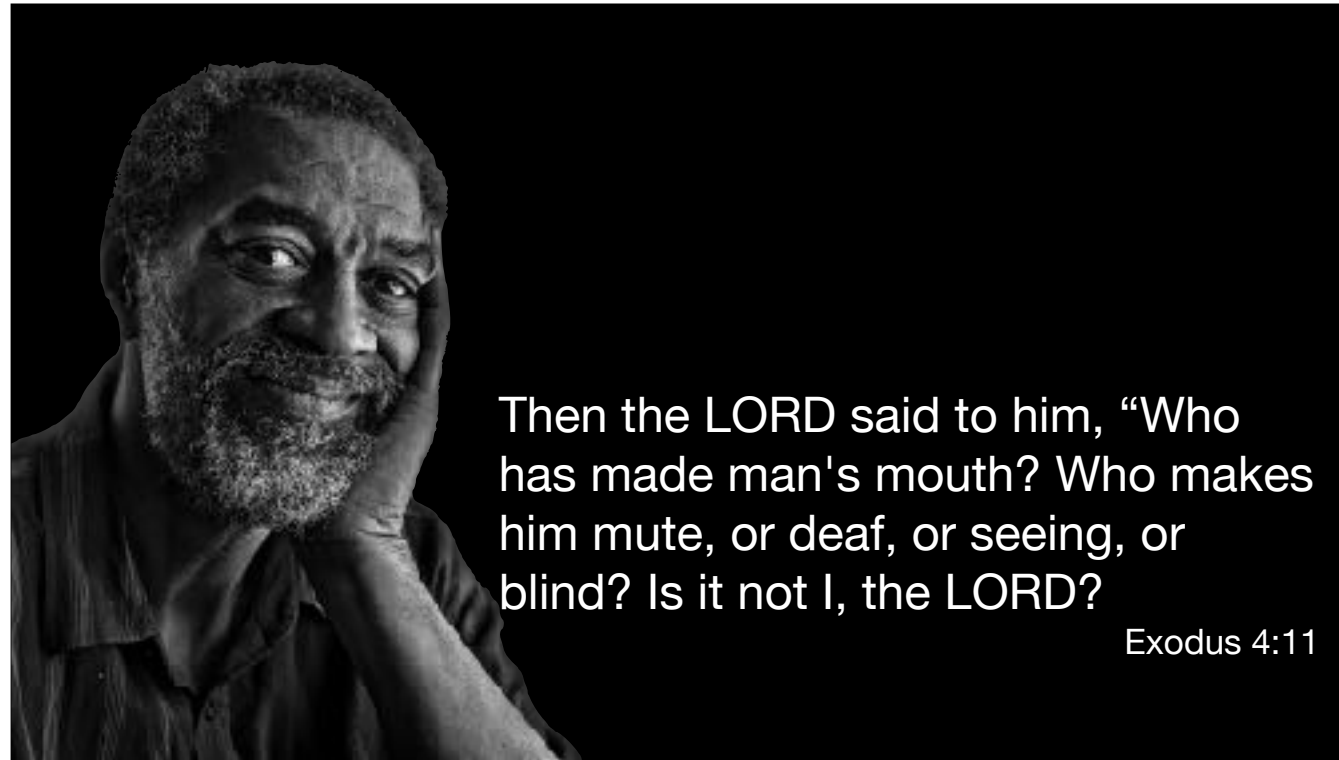
- 35 But someone will ask, “How are the dead raised? With what kind of body do they come?”

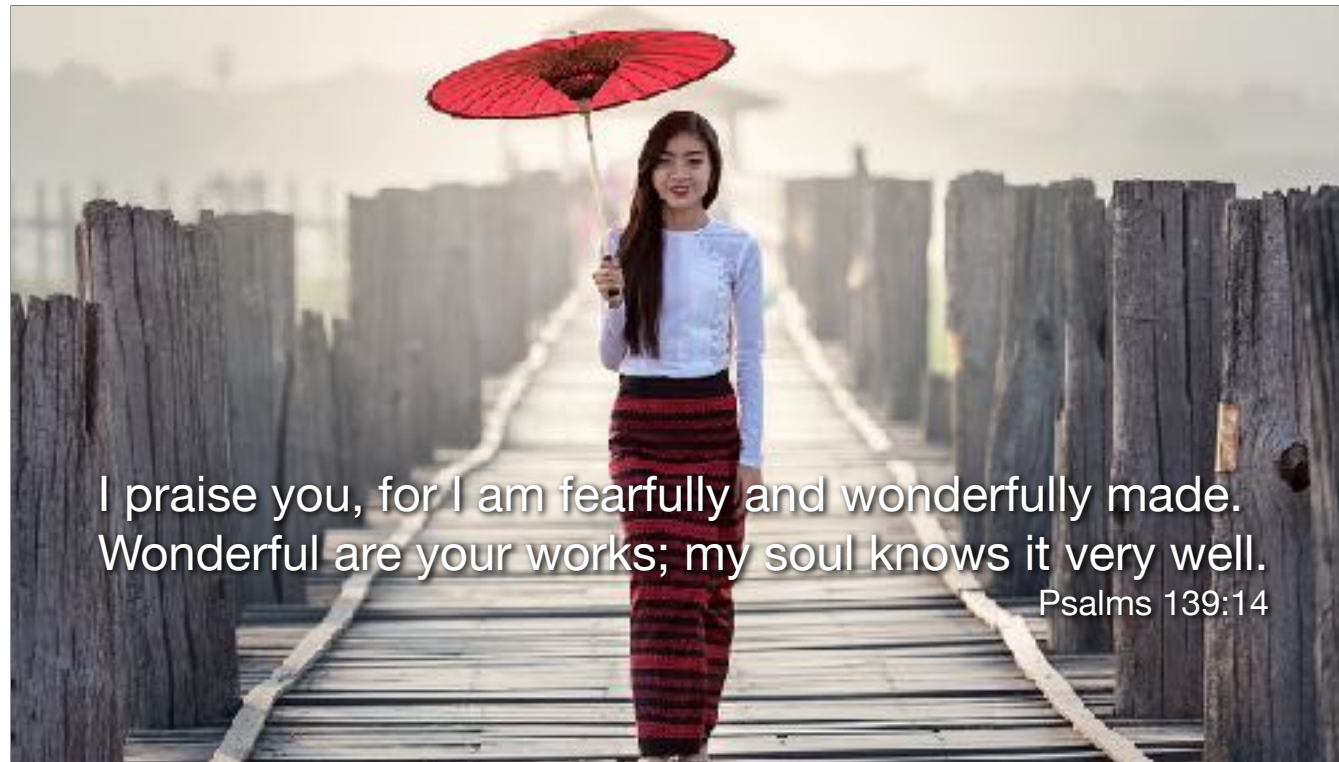

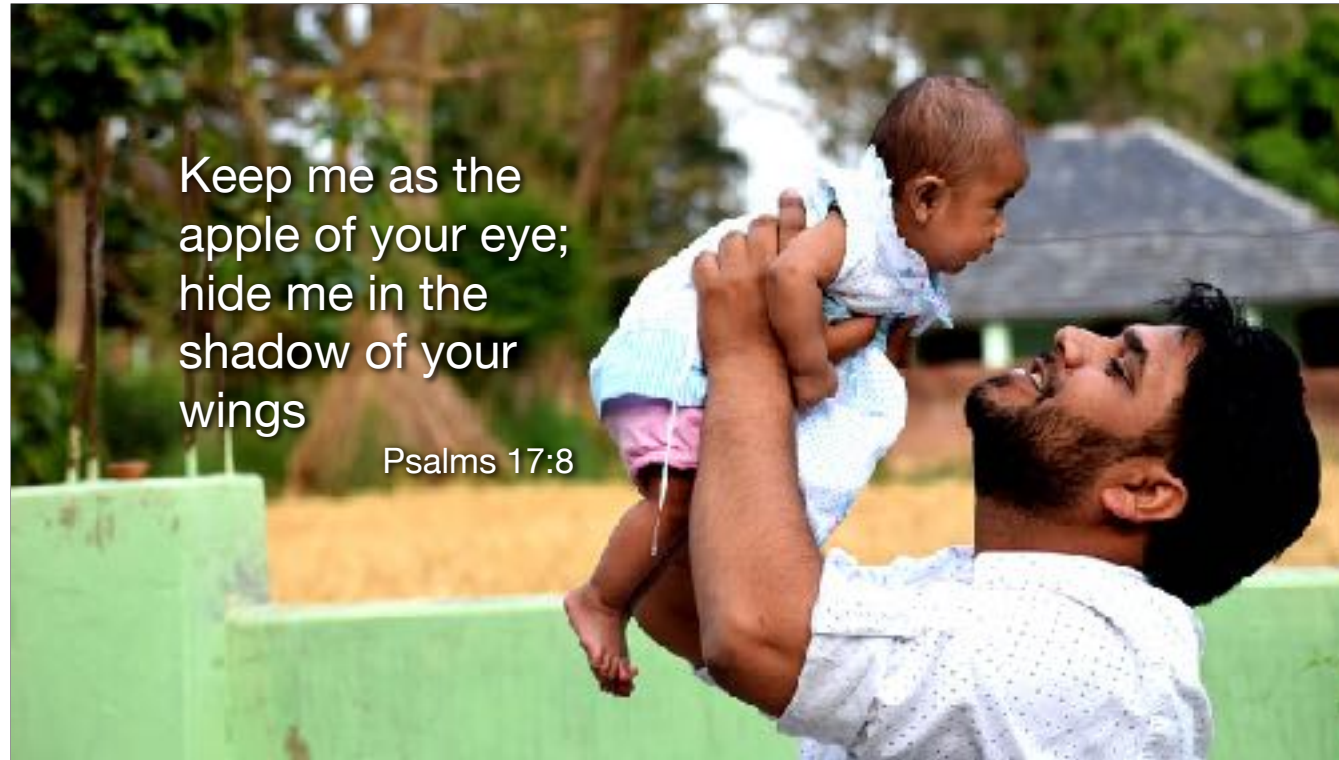

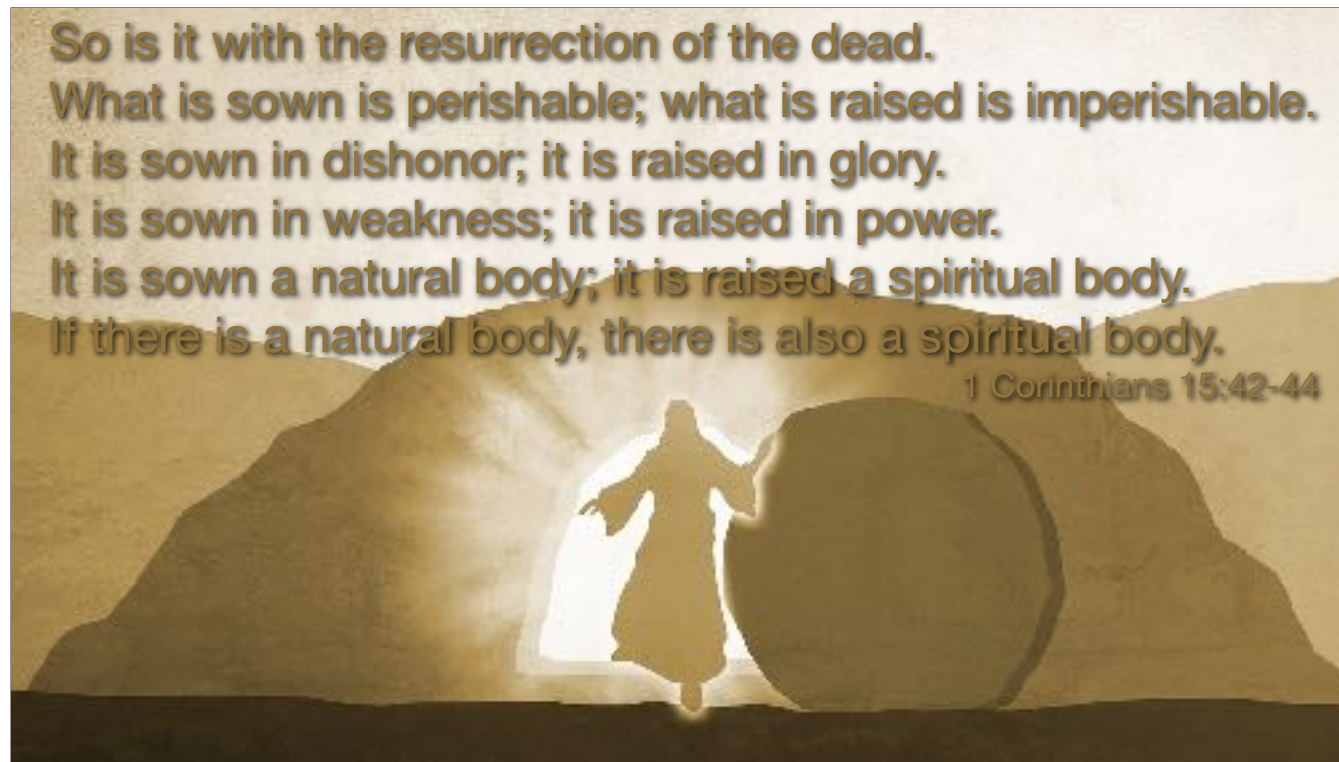
