One Thing: Martha & Mary

Luke 10:38-42; John 11:1-46; John 12:1-8

Synopsis: Martha and Mary are often portrayed as a contrast in choosing the right priorities, but that's based on an oversimplified application. There's so much more in the character of these women that's important for us to learn. The "One Thing" in this passage is presented as Jesus and keeping our focus on him is paramount, whether we are busy serving or burdened with sorrows. We can go to him and serve him and listen to him and worship him.
