
- · God with us .... the humanity and love of Jesus

- · God With Us
  - · What does it mean that God is with us?
- · Fair-weather friend those with us only when things go well, but if things are bad, mysteriously disappear
- · A true friend is with you through it all
  - · John 15:13 Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends.


· Luke 23:39 One of the criminals who were hanged railed at him, saying, "Are you not the Christ? Save yourself and us!"




· Luke 23:42 And he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."




· Luke 23:43 And he said to him, "Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in paradise."




- · Me with God

  - · Which response do you have to Jesus?




- · Galatians 2:20

    - · who loved me and gave himself for me.




- · Consider just how different this is for the Pharisee Saul: Acts 26:9-11
  - $\cdot$  9 "I myself was convinced that I ought to do many things in opposing the name of Jesus of Nazareth.
  - 10 And I did so in Jerusalem.
    - · I not only locked up many of the saints in prison after receiving authority from the chief priests,
    - · but when they were put to death I cast my vote against them.
    - $\cdot$  11 And I punished them often in all the synagogues and
    - · tried to make them blaspheme,
  - · and in raging fury against them I persecuted them even to foreign cities.




- · What does this mean to be crucified with Christ?
  - · Romans 6:3 Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?
  - · Romans 6:5 For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his.




• Romans 6:6 We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin.




· Galatians 5:24 And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.




· Galatians 6:14 But far be it from me to boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.



• 1 Peter 2:24 He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.






- · Romans 6:7 For one who has died has been set free from sin.
- · FREEDOM




- · So How do I now Live?
